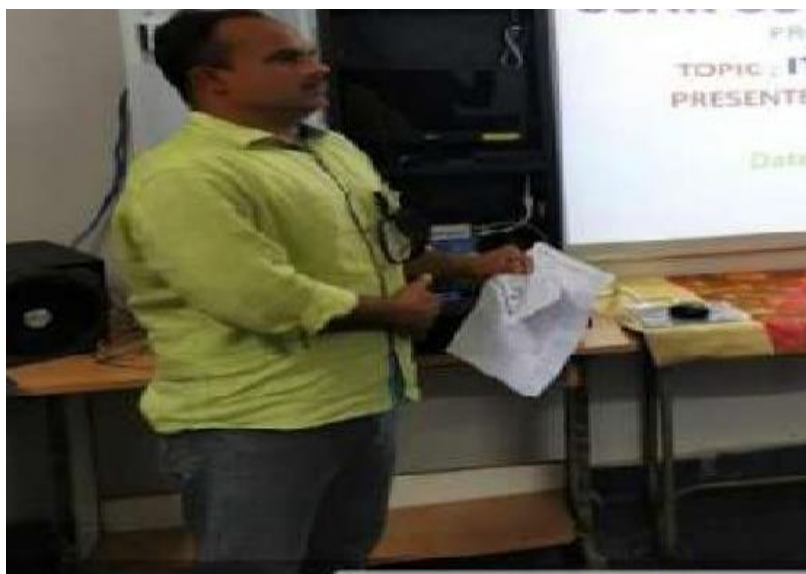

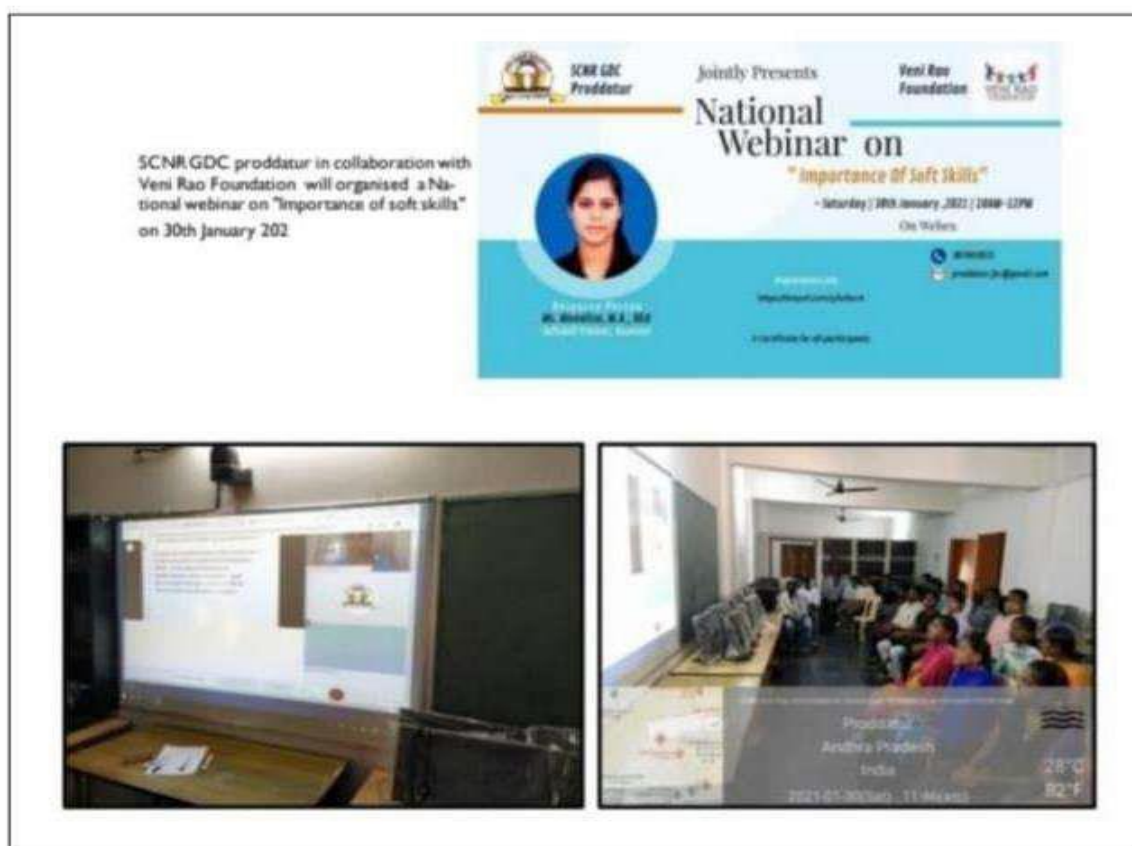


Dr. Muniswamy conducting workshop on preparation of CCE LMS Videos

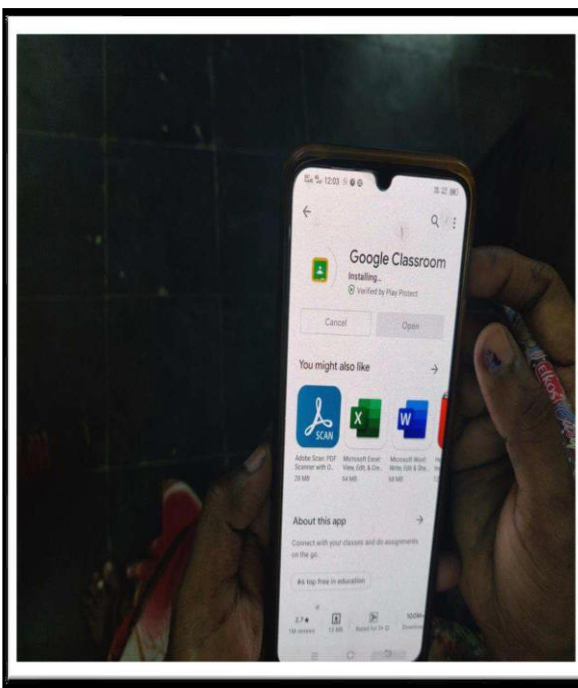


Dr. G. V. Lokeshwar Reddy addressing the gathering on MS-OFFICE

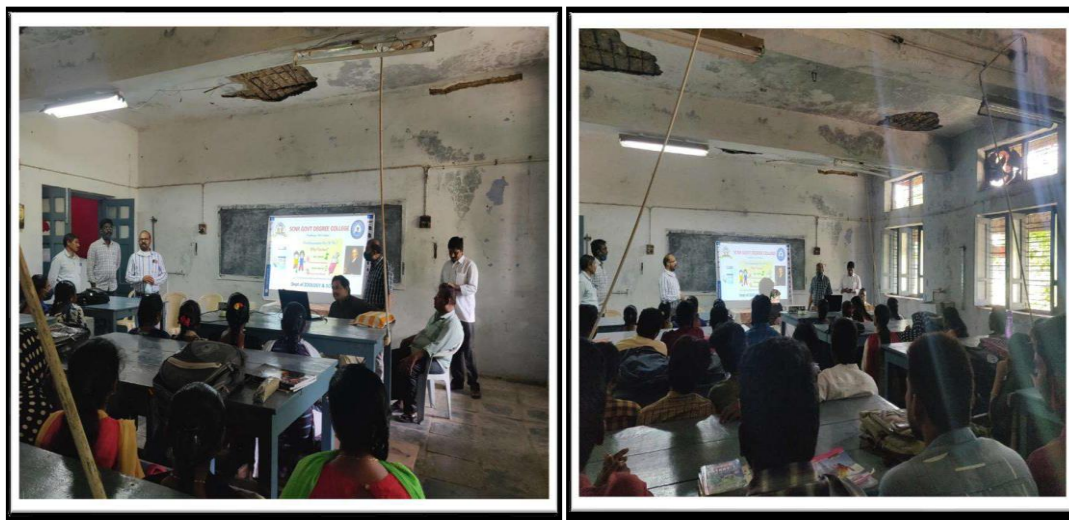
