Sub: Collegiate Education –CSP & Short-Term Internships of A.Y. 2023-2024—CSP & Internships Identification - Students Mapping to Mentors and Internships.

As per reference (3) cited, 2-Month Community Service Project (CSP) during the intervening summer vacation between the first and second years of Study (i.e., after 2nd Semester and before the 3rd Semester), Short term Internship of 2-Months during intervening summer vacation between the second and third years of study i.e., after the 4th Semester and before the 5th Semester is mandatory for all students. As per the timelines of universities for the A.Y. 2023-2024, CSP and Short-Term Internships are about to start soon.

Hence all the Principals, Internship Coordinators and Lecturers (Mentors) of all Government Degree Colleges are informed to take measures the identification of industries and to strictly follow the CSP & Internships guidelines and timelines given by the affiliating Universities while following the instructions given below

Procedure to Identify the Industries:

1. The students who have Computer Science or Computer Application as one of the subject are eligible for Online Internships or Physical Internships. Other specialization students have to do only Physical Internships.
2. The industries shall be identified from the following Sources:
 - a. APSCHE website.
 - b. List identified by Affiliated Universities.
 - c. List identified by the District Collectors
 - d. List of Industries from the Industry department given in I-MAP.
 - e. List identified by the Colleges.

f. In addition to the above, the following are few industries which expressed willingness to implement

3. If the Industries are identified from I-MAP Industries list, then the Principals, Internship Coordinators and Mentors are instructed to contact the SPOC(Single Point of Contact) person of the industry and get approval for the number of Internships they are willing to offer.
4. Student may be encouraged to do Paid Internships where the industries are willing to give a stipend (a fixed amount) to their internship map.
5. Orient the students about the opportunities of continuing in the industry after completion of the internship based on their dedication, commitment to work, willingness to learn and opportunities available with the select industries.

Procedure to Allot Mentors:

1. The Principals and Internship Coordinators are instructed to identify all Teaching faculty as the Mentors and allocated students. No Lecturer is exempted from the Internship Mentor Role.
2. Every mentor must be allotted for all three types of Internships in the Academic Year. i.e., every mentor should be allotted students who are going for Community Service Projects, Short-Term Internships and Semester Internships in that academic year.
3. The same mentor should be allotted to all types of Internships of the allotted student batches. For example, if a mentor is allotted for a batch of students for the Community Service Project, then the same mentor will also guide the same batch of students when they are doing Short-Term Internships during their second year and Semester Internship during their final year, this will also strengthen Mentor-Mentee relation and Counselling system.

Procedure to Map Internships to the Students:

While mapping industries/internships to the students, the mentor should give priority to the relevant specialization of the students.

Procedure for Mapping of Internships to the Students:

In A.Y. 2022-2023, CCE launched an APP called I-MAP to monitor the Internship activities of Students & Mentors. All Students who are doing their Short-Term Internships are to be mandatorily mapped to Internships, industries and Mentors in I-MAP Portal. In I-MAP, Tasks are to be given by mentors and students have to submit their logbooks which are to be verified by the concerned mentor. The portal for registration of students is available now.
