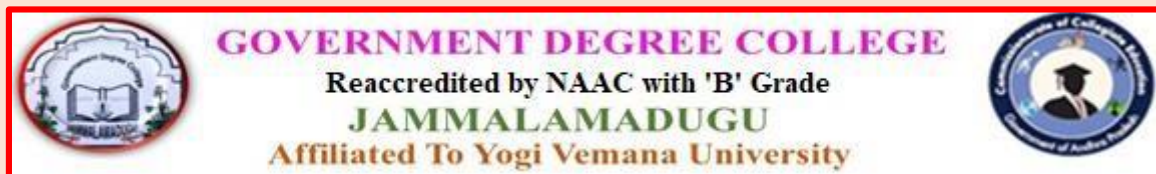

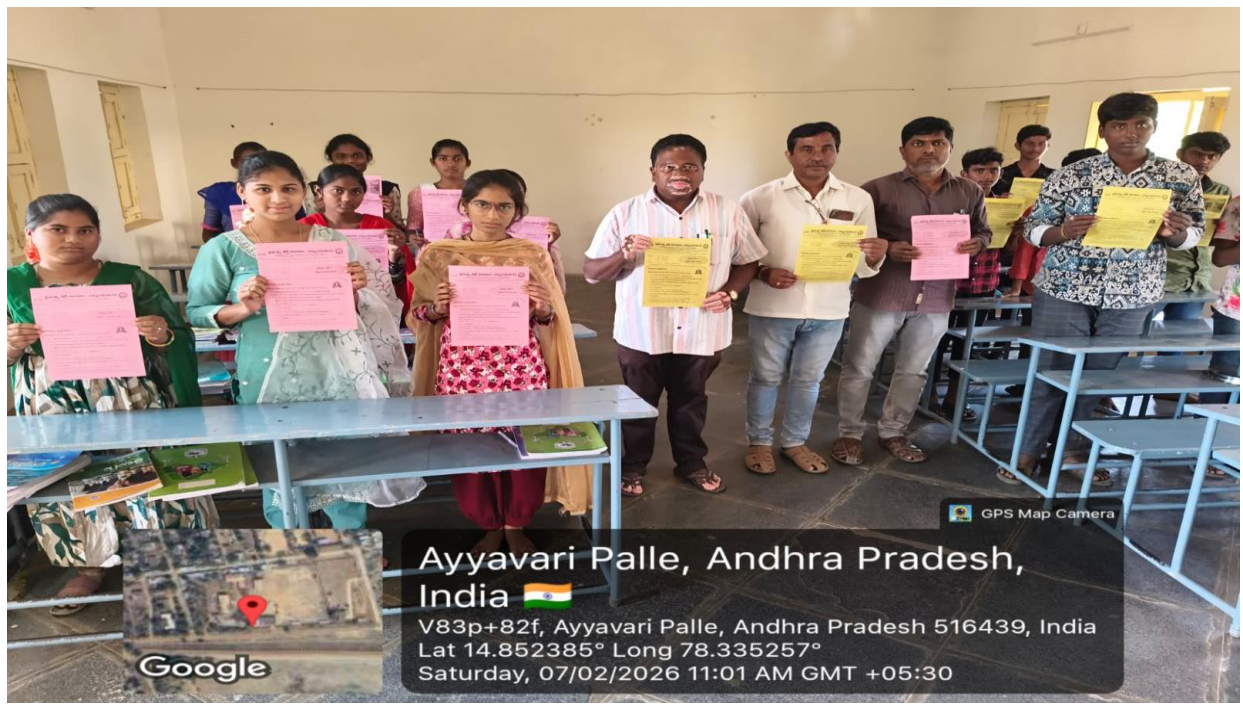

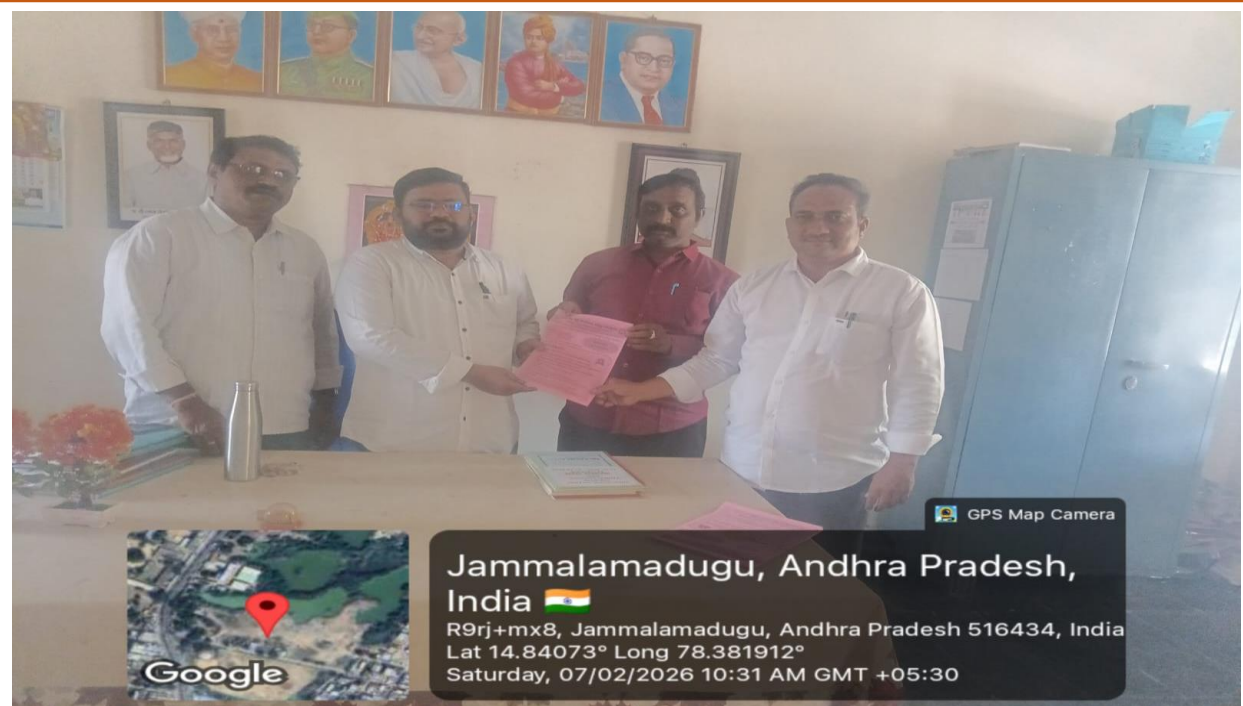
ADMISSION CAMPAINING AT JUNIOR COLLEGES

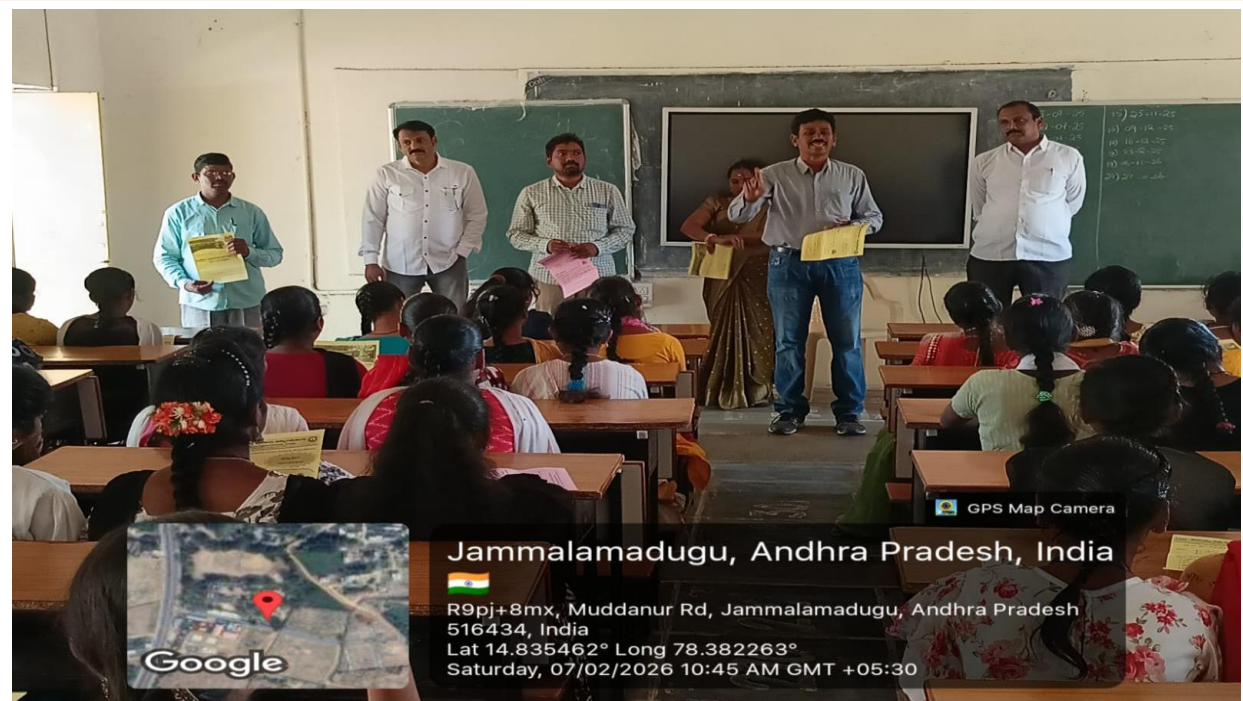

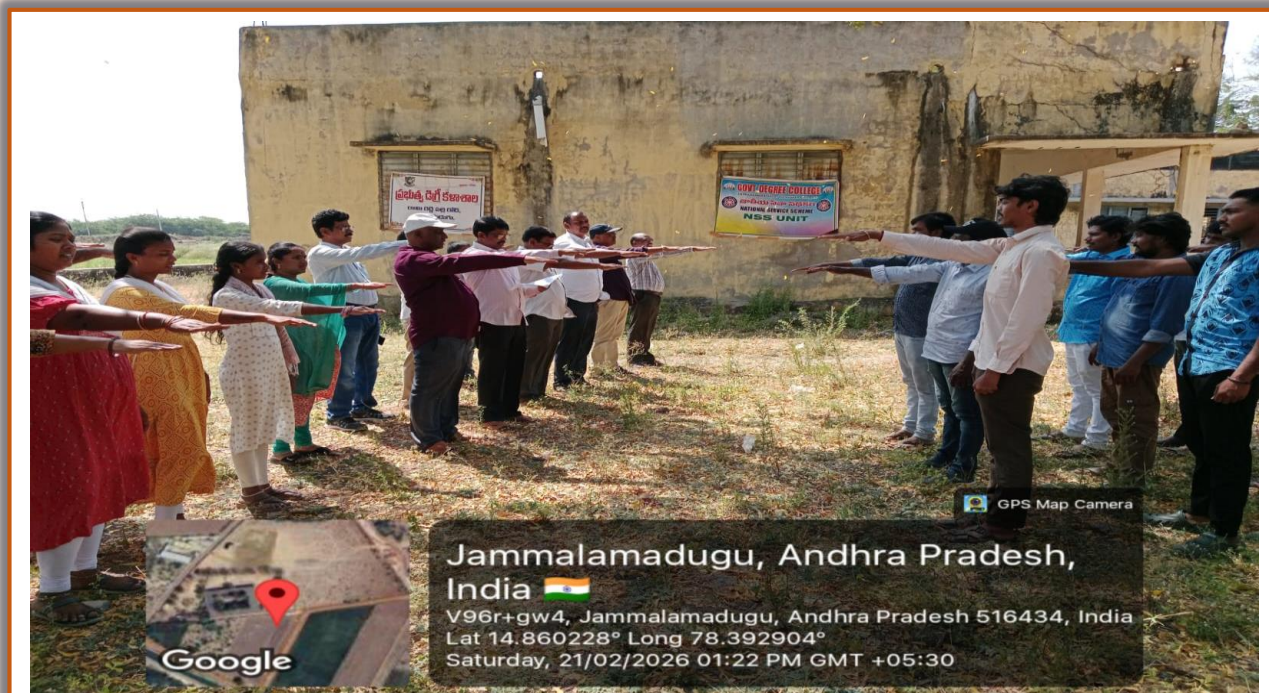

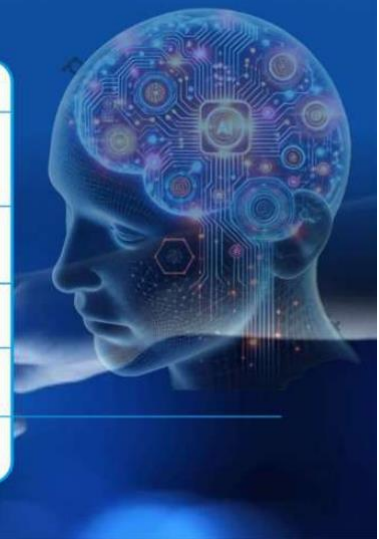

Manual Input — Human-Collected Data

The oldest, most controlled, and most commonly used data collection method

Manual Input = Data collected directly by humans — by filling forms, conducting surveys, entering information by hand, or curating content through human judgment. This data is deliberate and purposeful — collected for a specific reason.

Types of Manual Input:

- Surveys and Questionnaires
- Forms and Registration Systems
- Human-Curated Entries
- Citizen Science Data Collection

Manual Data Collection — Strengths vs Limitations

Strength	Limitation
High accuracy when done carefully	Slow — one entry at a time
Humans catch nuances machines miss	Expensive — requires human effort
Flexible — can collect any type of data	Human error — typos, wrong entries
Best for small, high-quality datasets	Cannot scale to millions of data points

Quality Tips for Manual Data Collection:

- Use dropdown menus instead of free text wherever possible (fewer typos)
- Add validation rules to forms — wrong format = form rejects the entry
- Double-check critical fields (student ID, dates) with a second human
- Always include a "data collection date" field — old data misleads AI

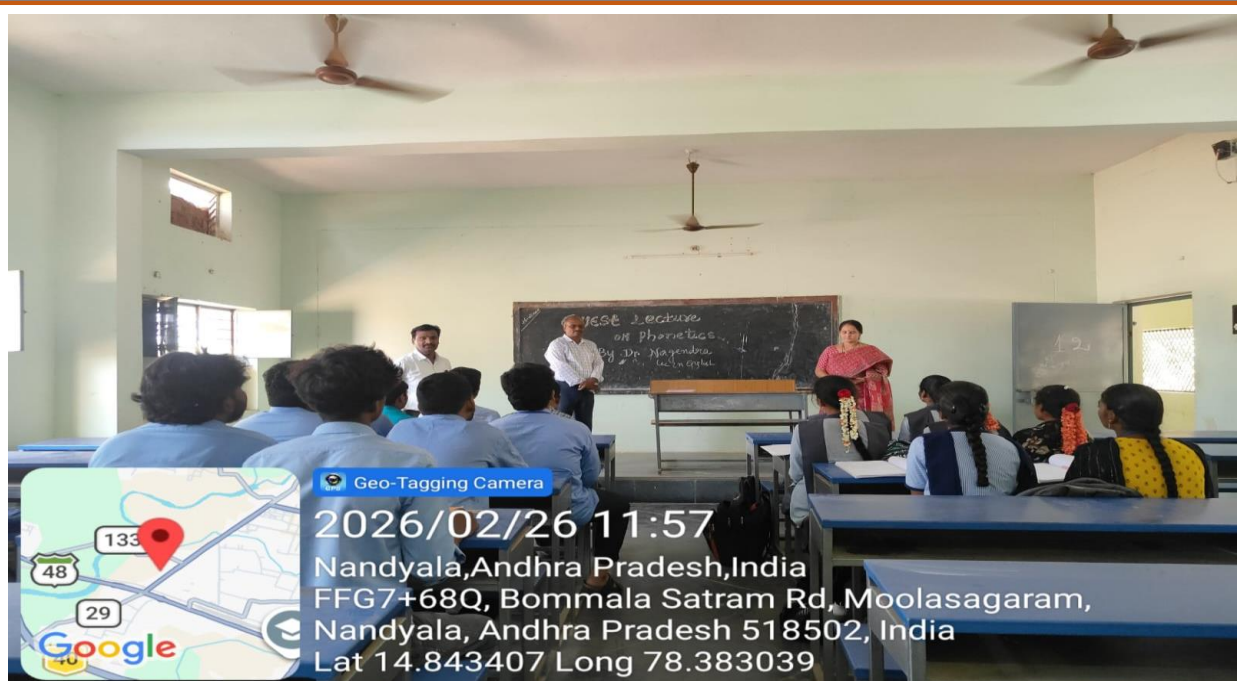
